## Maths We will:



-count up to and beyond 20 -sequence numbers to 20 -understand that numbers stay the same even if objects are moved around -compare and order numbers to 20 -identify numbers and show an understanding using pictures -count in 2s, 5s and 10s -know what one more or less means when counting in 1s -know what more or less means when counting in 10s -find patterns in numbers know what the words equals, more than, less than, most, least mean.

SMART Maths: recognise British coins, use mathematical language such as lighter/heavier and full/half full, weigh biscuits and ingredients in a role play context.

We will focus on what prayer means in different faiths and how people pray.

## P.E.



We will develop our awareness of 'multi skills' through learning the rules of and playing invasion games. We will also, practise skills for coordination.

## D.T.



We will design a playground for the Frederick Walker Garden and create models.

We will to identify, name and label the basic parts of the body and find out which part of the body is associated with each sense.
